Do you want to get active against climate change and are interested in media campaigning? Then join the newest project of IFM-SEI: 'All together against climate change'!

Throughout the project you will receive professional training in campaigning using media tools and learn and exchange about consequences of climate change in an international group.

Your local group will receive **equipment and funding** needed to carry out the campaign:

- A laptop complete with software
- A video camera
- 500 Euro for campaign materials

There are spaces for **3 participants from 9 European IFM-SEI organisations** to take part in this project. The participants from one country should be from the same city or region, if possible. This will make it easier to carry out the local campaigns together.

The participants should:

- be between 18 and 30
- be able to communicate in English (or have one person in the delegation who can help the other two)
- be volunteers for their organisation and have the possibility to carry out a campaign together with a children or youth group
- most importantly be motivated to take part in an exciting long-term project
- be available to participate in all of the following activities:

February – July 2011	E-learning activities on climate change and media A monthly 'task' for the participants: A question to think about alone or with their youth group. The results will be shared online with the rest of the group.
13-22 May 2011	Training Course I A 10-day long meeting in May 2011 in Germany with professional training in media campaigning and education on the causes and consequences of climate change

May 2011 – December 2011	Local campaigns Develop and run local media campaigns against climate change together with other young people
30 July – 9 August 2011	Co-Camp Participation at the international camp of Woodcraft Folk in the UK from 30 July to 9 August running workshops and activities on climate change and campaigning for others at the camp
November 2011	Resource Development Meeting A 4-day meeting in Prague to draft a handbook for other group leaders on climate change campaigns, based on our experiences
February 2012	Training Course II A training course prepared and facilitated by some of the project's participants for more group leaders to get to know the handbook and start their own campaigns

The exact dates are not fixed yet, but we will set them as soon as possible.

Costs (for participants or the organisations, you should discuss this with your organisation)

- Ten-day Training Course: 50 Euro
- Resource development meeting: 30 Euro
- Co-camp: 200 Euro for participants from Western Europe, 100 Euro for participants from Czech Republic, Slovakia and Latvia
- + 30% travel costs for each activity
